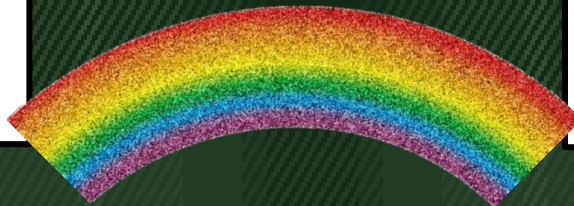
health/safety
